The top 10 most important reasons why dental care is really important for your pets:

1. A pet with healthy teeth equals a pet with better breath!
2. Dental disease can actually lead to problems with your pet's organs, such as the heart.
3. Retained baby teeth can cause problems in pets too. Did you know that fully grown dogs have 42 teeth and fully grown cats have 30 teeth? Before their adult teeth grow in, their baby teeth have to fall out. Sometimes, not all of the baby teeth want to come out and this can lead to problems like gum irritation and tartar buildup.
4. Caring for your pet's teeth can prevent other health problems, saving you lots of money over the long term!
5. You need regular dental care and you brush your teeth everyday – why wouldn't your pet? Your veterinary nurse can help you learn to brush your dog and cat's teeth.
6. Did you know that 4 out of 5 dogs over the age of 3 years have some sort of periodontal disease? It can be caused by the buildup of plaque, so it's important to have regular dental checkups and cleaning.
7. Pets that don't get dental care can lose their teeth – this can be terribly painful and cause serious health problems.
8. Your dog and cat are very good at hiding pain – you might never know that your pet has a serious dental problem until it's very advanced. This is yet another reason it's important to take your pet in for regular dental checkups.
